MAINTAINING THE CAMPUS INFRASTRUCTURE

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ADDITIONS TO THE WOMEN FRIENDLY FACILITIES

Ours is an inclusive campus. As regards the infrastructure provided, the separate common rooms and washrooms, the pedestrian pathways, wheelchairs, lifts, ramps, *divyangjan* washrooms are all part of ensuring the same.

We maneuver our efforts towards making the campus as inclusive as possible for the girl students as well as the female staff/faculty. Sanitary pad vending machines have been provided in the girls' hostels. To provide easier access of the facility, we have, in this quarter, installed sanitary pads vending machines, in many of our Academic Blocks too.

As regards sustainability some of you may have a query as to how these sanitary pads are dis-



posed. We would like to inform you that we have incinerators in the Girls' hostels. For the academic area we have one incinerator in the Turing block and a huge capacity incinerator placed centrally at the Waste Yard. The sanitary waste (separate dustbins are placed in all SHE washrooms) of the academic blocks, is ______

collected and incinerated centrally.

We in Administration strive to adhere to the guidelines of UGC as regards SDGs and have our own set of guidelines and actions too - be it in waste management, or in providing safe drinking water at the Academic buildings, or reducing of water wastage in the Academic buildings.

CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS SUSTAINABILITY

The principles of Sustainability speaks about the 7 Rs - Rethink, Refuse, Reduce, Repurpose, Reuse, Recycle and Rot.

We are proud that as regards the campus waste management we strive to ensure the principles of ROT as well as RECYCLE. Waste is segregated and disposed off as degradable and non-degradable. Efforts are now in place to inculcate the principle of REFUSE in our stakeholders, as regards single use plastic.

As regards REUSE, REPURPOSE, the principle is applied as regards the furniture. Rec-

ords of furniture held is maintained systematically by Administration so it is easy to anlayse what furniture can be reused and repurposed (within campus or shared with the needy). The final decision of repurposing/reusing is done in liaison with Office of Architecture and Design. In this year too we have reused a lot of furniture as tabulated below.

UPKEEP OF THE CAMPUS

Continuous efforts have gone into the upkeep of the campus in this quarter too. This includes cleanliness routine, cleaning of PCs of computer labs to improve their performance, cleaning of record store rooms to ensure they are clear of termites and ensuring timely termite treatment contracts, monitoring of maintenance requirements for the infrastructure and proper waste management, surprise check of venues, etc.









BLOOM GUEST HOUSE

There are two Guest Room areas in our campus—The Explore Nest (above Exploretorium) and The Bloom Nest (above D'Art Gallery). The Explore Nest guest rooms were taken over in this quarter in December. From this quarter, the upkeep of both these venues is being handled by Administration. There are many actions in place, and in process now, to revamp the Bloom Nest guest rooms,

Continuous and meticulous efforts are being put in to maintain the beautiful venues, which shall be a temporary home to many of our visiting faculty, trainers, and other guests.









































MAINTENANCE OF REFRESHMENT AREAS

The most preferred rendezvous of all students and staff would be the various refreshment areas of our campus. These include the SquareOne, Square Two, Circle One, the various counters outside Square One and Biriyani Hunter (which is situated in the Omega Zone since this quarter) etc.



Refreshments are served at these venues from 8:30 am and continue till 9 pm. Hence, there are teams that handle the task of keeping these venues ready. The work of the Housekeeping support team starts much before the counter services commence and continue even after the counter services are



closed. Be it summer, autumn or winter - cleanliness has to be ensured.

It is an earnest request to all stakeholders to kindly appreciate the necessity to not litter and to use the dustbins. Afterall cleanliness is next to godliness....!!



MAINTENANCE OF THE CAMPUS INFRASTRUCTURE

A broken furniture or fused bulbs in a clean room or a door that creaks when opening etc., would hamper the appearance of the room as well as the comfort of the users. For corrective maintenance the complaints are raised by Administration with the concerned Maintenance teams (Electrical or General) by the Administration and monitored for a closure.

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

Administration takes preventive measures for concerns like termites and for equipment like the water filters as well as the ROs. The Annual Maintenance Contracts for the termites are monitored and services ensured through continuous monitoring.

In this quarter too we had the termite treatment done for various venues and the servicing of the RO Plant at Square One. Some of these annuals contract were renewed in this quarter as the contracts commenced from the New Year.

To enable to handle the concerns of termites /rodents in record store rooms, all schools/ col-

leges and departments, are requested to ensure cleaning of their record stores at least once a month, through and in liaison with Administration.






INVENTORY RECORDS

Only what is measured can be managed and for that it is necessary for Administration to keep a record of the infrastructure being managed, the human resource available, the material resource being procured and utilized, and so much more.

Inventory records are maintained online and is updated annually, online, after an inventory audit. As regards the routine changes, the records are maintained manually. In this quarter, the updating of inventory records of the buildings and venues added/renovated, has been initiated. Audit of inventory of the various administrative blocks, common venues as well as the refreshment venues is also ordered and would be completed by end of January 2023.

SHIFTING

An event, a venue handover or takeover, furniture setting in any space, Diwali gifts distribution, a pooja, an orientation, students conducting some propagation activities, or a venue readiness - shifting is a part of all activities, both before and after. The teams involved in shifting are from the central pool of administration, where manpower has to be detailed in routine, from various ven-

ues. Be it day or night, sunny or foggy, the shifting has to take place. The task of shifting involves a lot of planning, monitoring, space management, manpower management., as well as records management. Kudos and hats off to this amazing team.

















VENUES FOR EVENTS

Venues for events are booked on line by the users and these are centrally allotted by Administration. While the venues need to well maintained, coordination and required support for the events is also ensured by Administration.

In this quarter there were a total of 437 demands for the various halls and venues, out of which the users cancelled 28 demands.


Hence the Administration team made two separate arrangements at the Exploretorium, based on the requirements of the users.




TOKENISING HAPPINESS














WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF FASHION






GLOBAL WEEK 2022
















SAMMAAN SAMAROH






