



cally created space was further decorated by Team Administration before handing over to the Happiness Team for the inaugural.








EXPLORE LAB GETS READY










TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATIONS














MAINTAINING A CLEAN CAMPIS







venue with colors, energy, enthusiasm, and for us,...a lot of pride too!! Well, the venue was set up by Team Administration.
