


ed by the concerned users. These venues , once completed , are handed over to the Office of Administration.

THE BLOCK CALLED ROCKEFELLER.....!!






No words can explain the edifice - THE ROCKEFELLER Block !!






HACKATHON FINALE

To parallel the décor of the stage to the eminence of the artists this year, Team Administration envisaged a themes full of vibrant colors and a touch of tradition.





The waste segregation and proper disposal as well as the write off and submission of broken furniture and non-repairable furniture and fixtures for disposal as scrap also need to be monitored.




